1. European Dog Show 2020

As you probably already know, the Kinološka zveza Slovenije – the Cynological Association of Slovenia - has been compelled to postpone the European Dog Show in Celje in October this year to a later time due to the Covid-19 situation.

The general committee of the Europe Section understands which disappointment it must be for the Kinološka zveza Slovenije, but under the circumstances given there was no other way.

It is therefore with great pleasure that we can inform you that the MEOE – the Hungarian Kennel Club – and the Kinološka zveza Slovenije have joined together to organize partly the EDS 2021 in Budapest on 20-23 May 2021 and partly the postponed EDS 2020 in Celje on either 25-28 May or 26-29 May 2021.

This means that both European Dog Shows can be carried through.

(The same is also the case for the FCI Americas & Caribbean Section. In this section, it has been decided, also for Covid-19 reasons, to postpone the 2020 section show to 2021, so that there will also in this section be two sections shows in 2021.)

All of us, who are every day engaged in our kennel clubs, are affected by the many cancelled events. Therefore, it is gratifying to see that kennel clubs co-operate and find good and creative solutions so that our sport can keep going.

We are aware that other already planned CACIB shows in this period can be affected by this decision, but we hope that there will be a general understanding for this.

As you know, the FCI has temporarily suspended the 300 km rule. The rule saying that no CACIB show can be held at the same time as the FCI world and section shows is valid for the EDS in Budapest, but not for the EDS 2020 in Celje. That means that already planned CACIB shows in Europe overlapping the EDS 2020 in Celje can be organized.

2. Europe Section General Assembly 2020

As you know, the yearly general assembly is always held on the day after the European Dog Show. Consequently, it should have taken place in Celje, Slovenia on 12 October 2020.

As the European Dog Show as mentioned above has been postponed to 2021, the general committee of the Europe Section considers it inexpedient to hold the general assembly – for essentially the same reasons that led to the postponement of the European Dog Show.

The section general committee therefore intends to hold both the 2020 and the 2021 general assemblies after the European Dog Show 2021 in Budapest, with the exact agendas that our articles of association provide.

This means that the main points of the 2020 general assembly will be the statement of accounts 2019-2020, elections for the general committee and election of host country for the EDS 2024. The essential points of the 2021 general assembly will be the statement of accounts 2020-2021 and election of host country for the EDS 2025.

The section general committee asks our members to express their opinion about the above two important topics. We please ask you to cast your vote by participating in the electronic Survey Monkey that will be sent to the e-mail address of all full members of the European Section.

Please cast your vote as soon as possible and before 20 July 2020.

The majority of the casted votes will be the decisive factor.
